ENTRIES

Citizen / Residence requirements and Clearance Procedure: In accordance with Rule 109 of ISU Regulations and all relevant ISU Communications, all skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

MUSIC AND PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

All competitors shall email music to CopenhagenDanceCup@gmail.com latest Friday, March 16th, 2018. Files should be named with competitor(s)'s name(s) and PD for pattern dance, SD for short dance and FD for free dance. Competitors must have a back-up cd for each program.

With the entry forms, the "Program Content Sheet" must be returned to the organizer. It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet must be completed precisely by each skater/couple in English using the terminology listed in the respective ISU Communication and the enclosed list of required elements in Solo Dance.

DRAW

There will be an electronic draw on Wednesday, March 28th, 2018.

The starting orders will be published at our website.

There will be no draw after the short dances/pattern dances as the order of free dance will be in reversed order related to the result of the short dances/pattern dances.

JUDGING SYSTEM

The ISU Judging System will be used.

MEALS, LODGING and TRAVEL EXPENSES

The Organizer will provide accommodation and meals for the invited Officials and for one judge from each participating club during the competition.

Travel expenses will be paid to the invited officials based on economy fare.

All Competitors, Coaches and Team Leaders have to bear their own expenses.

REGISTRATION

All Referees, Judges, Technical Panels, Competitors, Team Leaders, Coaches and representatives from each club taking part in the competitions are requested to register at the rink from 15.00 on Friday March 30th, 2018.

For Novice Free Dance, in all Required Elements, only features up to **Level 3** will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

One (1) Pattern Dance without Key Points is to be skated:

#1 Fourteenstep (4 Seq.)

Free Dance:

Technical requirements:

- a) One Short Lift
- b) One Set of Synchronized Twizzles
- c) One Straight Line Step Sequence in Hold (MiSt, DiSt)
- d) One Choreographic Element: Choreographic Spinning Movement or Choreographic Twizzling Movement

Duration: 2.30 min. +/- 10 sec.

The **Dance Spin** is not included in the list of Required Elements for the Pre-novice Free Dance. Nevertheless, a spinning movement skated by the couple

together in any hold around common axis on one foot (or two feet) with any number of rotations is permitted. A couple may choose to use this movement as part of their choreography. The Technical Panel will ignore these movements and the Judges will not consider these movements as one of the permitted stops.

For Pre-novice Free Dance, in all Required Elements, only features up to **Level 2** will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

Juvenile – Non-ISU Category

Pattern Dance in accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2016, Rules 707, 708 and all pertinent ISU Communications.

One (1) Pattern Dance without Key Points is to be skated:

Rhythm Blues (4 Seq.) (See Non-ISU Dances)

Free Dance:

Technical requirements:

a) One Short Lift

b) One Set of Synchronized Twizzles

c) One Straight Line Step Sequence in Hold or not in Hold

Duration: 1.30 min. +/- 10 sec.

The **Dance Spin** is not included in the list of Required Elements for the Pre-novice Free Dance. Nevertheless, a spinning movement skated by the couple together in any hold around common axis on one foot (or two feet) with any number of rotations is permitted. A couple may choose to use this movement as part of their choreography. The Technical Panel will ignore these movements and the Judges will not consider these movements as one of the permitted stops.

For Pre-novice Free Dance, in all Required Elements, only features up to **Level 2** will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

- c) One long pose (sLoPo) (min. 3 sec. in each pose)
- d) One spin (free of choice) (sSp min. 3 revolutions or sCoSp min. 3 revolutions on each foot)

Pattern Dances in accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2016, Rules 707, 708 all pertinent ISU Communications.

Two (2) Pattern Dances without Key Points are to be skated:

Swing Dance (2 Seq.) (See Non-ISU Dances)

Golden Skaters Waltz (2 Seq.) (See Non-ISU Dances)

Skaters **shall** provide their own music for the **Swing Dance** 104 beats per minute \pm 2 beats per minute

Free Dance:

Technical requirements:

- a) One straight line step sequences (sMiSt or sDiSt)
- b) One short pose (sShPo) (max 7 sec.)
- c) One spin (free of choice) (sSp min. 3 revolutions or sCoSp min. 3 revolutions on each foot)

Duration: Maximum 2.00 min.

In all required elements only features up to **Level 2** will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.
